University of Miami School of Law Technology Law Club Constitution

Article I: Name

The name of this organization shall be the University of Miami School of Law Technology Law Club ("Tech Law Club").

Article II: Purpose

The purpose of this organization shall be to:

- 1. Connect law students with the local and national technology business and legal communities.
- 2. Foster student engagement with emerging legal issues in technology through events, research, writing, and workshops.
- Host legal and non-legal professionals in technology to speak, network, and collaborate with members.

Article III: Membership

- Membership shall be open to all currently enrolled students of the University of Miami School of Law.
- 2. This organization shall not discriminate based on race, color, religion, sex, age, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, veteran status, or national origin.

Article IV: Executive Board

- 1. The Executive Board shall consist of the following officers:
 - President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary
 - o Marketing Chair
 - o 2L Representative
 - 1L Representative (elected in the fall)
- 2. Additional positions may be added through amendments to the Bylaws and confirmed by a majority vote of the membership.

3. All officers must be active members in good standing.

Article V: Officer Terms and Elections

- 1. Officer terms shall run from April 1 to May 31 of the following academic year.
- 2. Elections shall be held in the spring semester before Spring Break.
- 3. Elections procedures shall be detailed in the Bylaws.
- 4. If no officers are elected by April 1, the organization will be considered inactive per UM Law policy.

Article VI: Amendments

- 1. Amendments to this Constitution require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present at a regular or special meeting.
- 2. At least one (1) week advance notice of the proposed amendment must be sent to the membership via email.

Article VII: Ratification

This Constitution becomes effective upon approval by a two-thirds vote of the founding or current membership and approval by the faculty advisor.
